#### CREATIVE RESPONSE

Ash Wednesday marks the first day of Lent. The association of the day with ashes goes back to the 6th century. For centuries, Christians have received ashes on the head as a reminder of mortality and a sign of sorrow for sin. To mark the beginning of Lent, set aside a period of time this week to 'unplug' from technology and luxuries. Choose not to watch TV, and to use computers and other electronic devices for leisure purposes. Eat simple foods and drink only water. Have a time of silence in your household during which you reflect on the gifts of God and your relationship with him.

# ACTION RESPONSE

The day before Ash Wednesday is called Shrove Tuesday. The name 'shrove' comes from the practice of being 'shriven' – going to church to confess your sins and receive absolution – before the start of Lent. Shrove Tuesday is also sometimes called Pancake Tuesday or Fat Tuesday, because households used up their remaining eggs and fats before Lent by making pancakes. Observe Shrove Tuesday with a pancake breakfast or dinner.
